Frequently Asked Questions:

1. When is the ICD-10 compliance date?

Any services rendered on or after October 1, 2015 will need to be submitted as ICD-10 codes rather than ICD-9 codes. However, providers may continue to submit claims using ICD-9 for inpatient procedure codes after 10/1/2015 ONLY if the DOS or DOD is prior to October 1, 2015.

2. Where can I find free ICD-10 code sets?

Free code sets are available at <http://cms.gov/Medicare/Coding/ICD10/>.

3. Are there free online webinars available?

Yes – Optum offers a (2) part ICD-10 webinar training. The trainings are structured to focus primarily on those codes that are risk adjusting, however, they provide much of the needed basic information as well. Here are the links to the upcoming webinars:
